Application for Film 199 – Independent Study

In accordance with a rule of the Academic Senate, a student who wishes to pursue an individual study project should submit a detailed proposal including the purpose of the course, a description of the subject and method, and a book list to the instructor who is to supervise the course. They should also attach their most recent transcript. A CalCentral printout is sufficient.

Note: projects that could be carried out within the framework of regularly scheduled courses will not be approved for 199 courses. Also, special attention should be paid to the following ruling of the Committee on Courses for the College of Letters and Science.

- 1. Students enrolled in 199 courses must have completed at least 60 semester units of undergraduate study and must be in good standing (2.0 GPA or better)
- 2. Credit for 199 courses in a single term may aggregate no more than 4 units.
- 3. Only a grade of Passed/Not Passed is to be assigned in 197, 198, and 199 courses.
- 4. No more than a total of 16 units of courses numbered 197, 198, and 199 may be used to meet the requirements for a Bachelor's degree.

Only 4 passed/not passed units may be used to fulfill the Film elective unit requirement.

The student should discuss the feasibility of his or her project with the proposed course instructor before submitting to the Department for approval.

- Description of the subject and study method
- Reading list for the course
