Application for Senior Honors Thesis

To be eligible for the **Film & Media Honors program**, students must be seniors with a **UC Berkeley GPA of 3.3 or higher**, and a **3.5 GPA or higher in major courses** taken at UC Berkeley. Honors students enroll in H195 for four units and complete a senior honors thesis. The thesis should be a substantial piece of writing on moving-image criticism, theory, or history. The production of a film or writing of a screenplay may be used as part of the preparation of the thesis and submitted as documentation or as an example. The thesis should be of sufficient depth and quality to earn an A-range grade.

For thesis writers: Complete this form and bring it, along with your most recent unofficial transcript and your proposal, to your prospective instructor/thesis sponsor. After obtaining your thesis sponsor's signature, submit the form, a copy of your proposal, and your unofficial transcript to the major advisor (filmmediaugadvising@berkeley.edu) by the the first day of classes. The advisor will obtain the UG Faculty Advisor's approval and then enroll you in 4 units of H195.
